Customer Advisory: HMM Announces Transpacific Service Change Dear Valued Customers, HMM intends to mitigate potential impact to your cargo considering the anticipated disruption to East and Gulf Coast services starting Tuesday, October 1, 2024.

HMM is making all efforts to avoid disruptions to our current vessel cargo. To ensure timely offloading of cargo prior to the shutdown, we have made the following vessel adjustments.

For North America Import, cargo originally booked to discharge at omitted ports will discharge at an alternate port as per following chart. HMM recommends picking up the cargo at alternate discharging ports prior to October 1, 2024.

For North America Export, cargo originally booked to the below vessels for the ports which are omitted will be shifted to other services calling the port prior to strike action if possible. If it is not possible, bookings will be rolled to the next vessel in the service to which it is currently booked. Revised booking confirmations will be sent for affected cargo.
