Please note the below – Canadian National Railway forecasted weather impacts (3/23 – 3/27)

FORECASTED WEATHER IMPACTS AND OPERATIONAL CHALLENGES

We anticipate some challenging operating conditions in two parts of the network and we ask that you be aware of changing local conditions and how they may impact your movement of goods. Based on the 7-day weather forecast, we currently have one system we are preparing for that is carrying a large amount of moisture and may impact our operations in the U.S. corridor as well as Eastern Canada through to the Maritimes:

- Winter storm from **March 23, Thursday, to March 27, Monday**, that may impact operations in Eastern Canada, through to the Maritimes. This storm could possibly bring heavy snowfall in Eastern Quebec into New Brunswick.
 - Spring storm from **March 23, Thursday, to March 27, Monday**, that may impact our U.S. operations (Chicago through to the Gulf Coast). This storm could bring heavy rainfall possibly causing localized flash flooding, high winds, severe storms and tornadoes.
