

Transpacific-West Coast Service Change Announcement

Dear Valued HMM Customer,

We are writing to inform you about some adjustments being made to our Transpacific-West Coast services in order to better meet the current demand fluctuations. These changes will go into effect starting from August (the exact sailing date will be announced shortly):

1. PS5 service will be temporarily suspended until further notice.
2. PS3, PS6, and PS7 services will be adjusted as follows:
 - PS3: We will be adding a Tokyo call to the existing route. The revised route will be *Nhava Sheva - Pipavav - Colombo - Port Kelang - Singapore - Cai Mep - Haiphong - Yantian - Los Angeles/Long Beach - Oakland - Tokyo (new) - Pusan - Shanghai - Ningbo - Shekou - Singapore - Port Kelang - Nhava Sheva.*
 - PS6: We will be adding a Shanghai call and omitting the Pusan call. The revised route will be *Qingdao - Shanghai (new) - Ningbo - Los Angeles/Long Beach - Oakland - Kobe - Qingdao.*
 - PS7: We will be adding a Pusan call to the existing route. The revised route will be *Singapore - Laem Chabang - Cai Mep - Hong Kong - Yantian - Pusan (new) - Los Angeles/Long Beach - Oakland - Hong Kong - Singapore.*

We assure you that these adjustments are aimed at optimizing our services and providing you with reliable weekly services. Please be advised that other THEA PS service (PS4, FP1) will remain unchanged. Furthermore, we want to assure you that HMM dedicated PS service, PSX, which began its first voyage in April, will continue its weekly service without any change.

We would like to take this opportunity to express our sincere gratitude for your ongoing support and trust. HMM looks forward to continuing to serve you with our best service.
