

Storage Policy for Union Pacific

Dear Valued HMM Customer,

Please note the below updated storage policy for Union Pacific Effective February 1, 2024.

Effective February 1, 2024, the terminology is being update to simplify the storage charges outlined in the Intermodal Terms and Conditions Section C.12

Union Pacific is modifying our storage policy to simplify the destination storage charges outlined in Intermodal Terms and Conditions (ITC) Section C.12. Effective February 1, 2024

Destination Storage. Once Union Pacific notifies the Notify Party that the Intermodal Unit is grounded and available for Outgate, Free Time will start at 0001 the day following the day of notification. All days are included for calculating Free Time, including Saturdays, Sunday, and holidays. If an Intermodal Terminal is closed for an entire calendar day for any reason, that day will not be included in the Free Time calculations. Domestic Traffic will be granted 24 hours of Free Time and International Traffic will be granted 48 hours of Free Time. Upon expiration of Free Time, any Intermodal Unit held at a Union Pacific Intermodal Terminal will be assessed a Storage Charge. Once Storage Charges commence, every day thereafter is subject to Storage Charges (including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays). If an Intermodal Terminal is closed for an entire calendar day for any reason, that day will not be included in the Storage Charge calculations. Storage Charges will not be waived due to failure of the Notify Party to provide notification to Customer or Broker. Any Commodity or Intermodal unit that is left on Union Pacific's property in excess of sixty (60) days after the notification date will be considered abandoned and the contents forfeited to Union Pacific.

The new storage policy will no longer hold storage fees during a holiday. As long as facility is open, storage fees will apply. The below storage holidays list is no longer applicable



Destination Storage Holidays

- > New Year's Day
- > Memorial Day
- > Independence Day (July 4th)
- > Labor Day
- > Thanksgiving Day
- > Friday after Thanksgiving
- > Christmas Eve
- > Christmas Day
- > New Year's Eve
- > Waterfront Strike observed (applicable ONLY for Union Pacific's ICTF California terminal)
- > Fat Tuesday (applicable ONLY for Union Pacific's New Orleans, LA (Avondale) terminal)

Note: applies only on the day celebrated by the City of New Orleans during its Mardi Gras celebration known in New Orleans, LA as "Fat Tuesday"

Lastly, Global 1 has been removed from Group 1 Terminals list.
